




St Dominic's College Maths Trail - California Hills Park, Ballyfermot.

Welcome to our Maths Trail - Let Mattie take you on a Mathastic journey around the park, opening your Maths Eyes to all the Maths in the world around you. The Trail begins inside the pedestrian gate beside the traffic lights at the Kylemore College end of the park.

To begin:

1. You will either need to download a qr scanner in order to scan the questions throughout the park on your phone or alternatively you can download the question sheets directly from St Dominics College or DCC website.
2. The stations are numbered 1-10 on wooden posts going anti-clockwise around the park.
3. There are 3 levels of questions at each station of varying degrees of difficulty. The first level (a) is suitable for early primary school students, level (b) is suitable for late primary/early secondary school students and level (c) is suitable for late secondary school students.
4. As you complete the trail, you will be asked to estimate some measurements - we suggest you might use your hands, feet or a students height or objects to help you do these measurements. On your return to the classroom, you can then measure the whatever aid you used to help to you obtain more accurate answers.
5. When you have finished answering all the questions on the 10 stations, you can compare your answers from our answer sheet found on St Dominic's College website.
6. Make sure to time how long it takes you to walk around the park as this will be needed for one of the final questions.
